### SELECTION PROCESS

1. Completed fundraiser proposal applications are due no later than 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 16, 2007.
2. The League's Fund Development Committee will conduct an initial review of all proposals to ensure applications are complete.
3. Proposed fundraisers will be presented to the membership at the February 13, 2007 General Membership meeting where members will have the opportunity to give feedback on the proposals and rank them in their order of preference. If it is necessary for a proposer to give a presentation at the General Membership Meeting, the Fund Development Committee will contact the respective proposer.
4. Following the GMM, the Fund Development Committee will thoroughly review all applications, taking into account membership feedback and preferences, and will make their recommendation to the Junior League of Miami, Inc. Board of Directors. If a presentation by the proposer of a fundraiser is needed for the Board of Directors meeting, the Fund Development Committee will contact the respective proposer.
5. On April 3, 2007, the Board of Directors will review the proposals and recommendation of the Fund Development Committee. Applicants will be notified by April 4, 2007 if their fundraiser has been approved.
